



One of the unmissable experiences on the Madeira Island are the Levadas – interior trails that cross the entire territory. Some are more challenging for adventurers, while others are more accessible to anyone. These paths offer the best way to explore the Laurisilva Forest, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, providing a perfect union with nature.

Thanks to the mild climate, it is possible to practice nautical, land, or aerial activities at any time of the year. In addition, you can opt for excursions around the island: to the northeast, discover Santana and its picturesque little houses, to the northwest, you can dive into the Natural Pools of Porto Moniz. If you prefer pebble beaches, west of Funchal, you can enjoy the enchanting beach of Fajã dos Padres, whose crystal-clear waters invite diving.

In Madeira, there is a spirit of celebration and festivity throughout the year. Among the most popular festivities are the fireworks display on New Year's Eve, Carnival, the Flower Festival in the spring, and the Atlantic Festival in the summer.

Seafood, fish, and cod are staples in the Madeiran menu. 
