Come and spend some days in Marvão, a village where you can see eagles flying along the coasts. in a massive granite ground able to protect you from all the hassles, the Pousada de Santa Maria has the surrounding peace, tranquility and rugged beauty will inspire a unique and absolutely original stay.


When starting the climb to the village, inside the castle walls, don't stop trying, at each turn, to wonder about the inaccessibility that led men to seek shelter here since the medieval times. The interesting history of this defensive castle that was conquered by the first king of Portugal might be a good suggestion to read when you find the inn and discover the extraordinary bar room.

This room, with a view of Spain and Serra da Estrela, is perched between the recovered white houses and gives the feeling of existing above the clouds and is fully covered in fog and seems to be the only real space in many kilometers. Dreamy and inspiring, this typical winter inn, with its rooms with lit fireplaces and burning aromatic wood crackling, has the neighboring granite massifs as neighbors - hosting a colony of griffins. In the summer, the attraction is also strong, with days of absolute visibility to ensure absolutely memorable images.

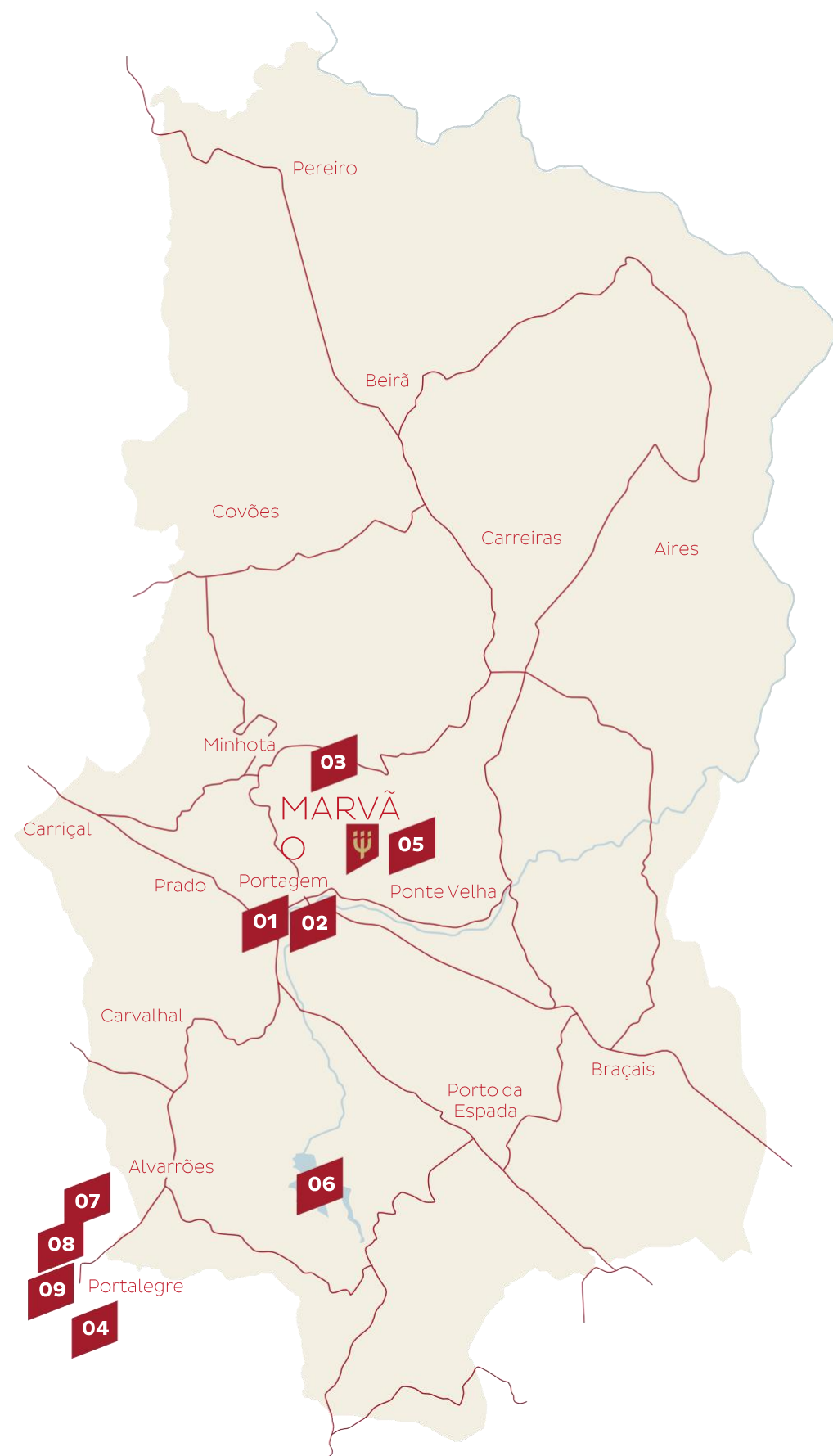

Marvão is a village surrounded by walls, that grew up around a castle, on the north side of S. Mountain made of granitic and scarp top with an altitude of 860m.

The village was founded by the Romans and in the Middle Age, it became the setting for many battles, functioning as a watchtower. The village is composed of small typical houses, most of them white, forming narrow streets, alleys, avenues and some gardens.

Being the highest village of Portugal, Marvão, has only a little chance for expanding itself. Thus, its tranquil atmosphere and the exceptional views onto the green valleys transmit much calm and make this village an ideal weekend destination.

One of the area's main attractions is the Leisure Centre in Portagem, which includes a river pool in the Sever River – its principle landmark – this will be an excellent choice for a leisure day with the family.

Thanks to the São Mamede Mountains Natural Park, activities like hunting, fishing and hiking on pedestrian trails are very common, as birdwatching is, a fascinating activity for all visitors. For all those who love adventure, hang gliding or tree climbing are also good options. The Marvão county has many celebrations and pilgrimages; the Chestnut Festival (Festa do Castanheiro) in November and the Al-Mossassa Festival (Islamic Festival) in October are the two events attracting the most visitors.

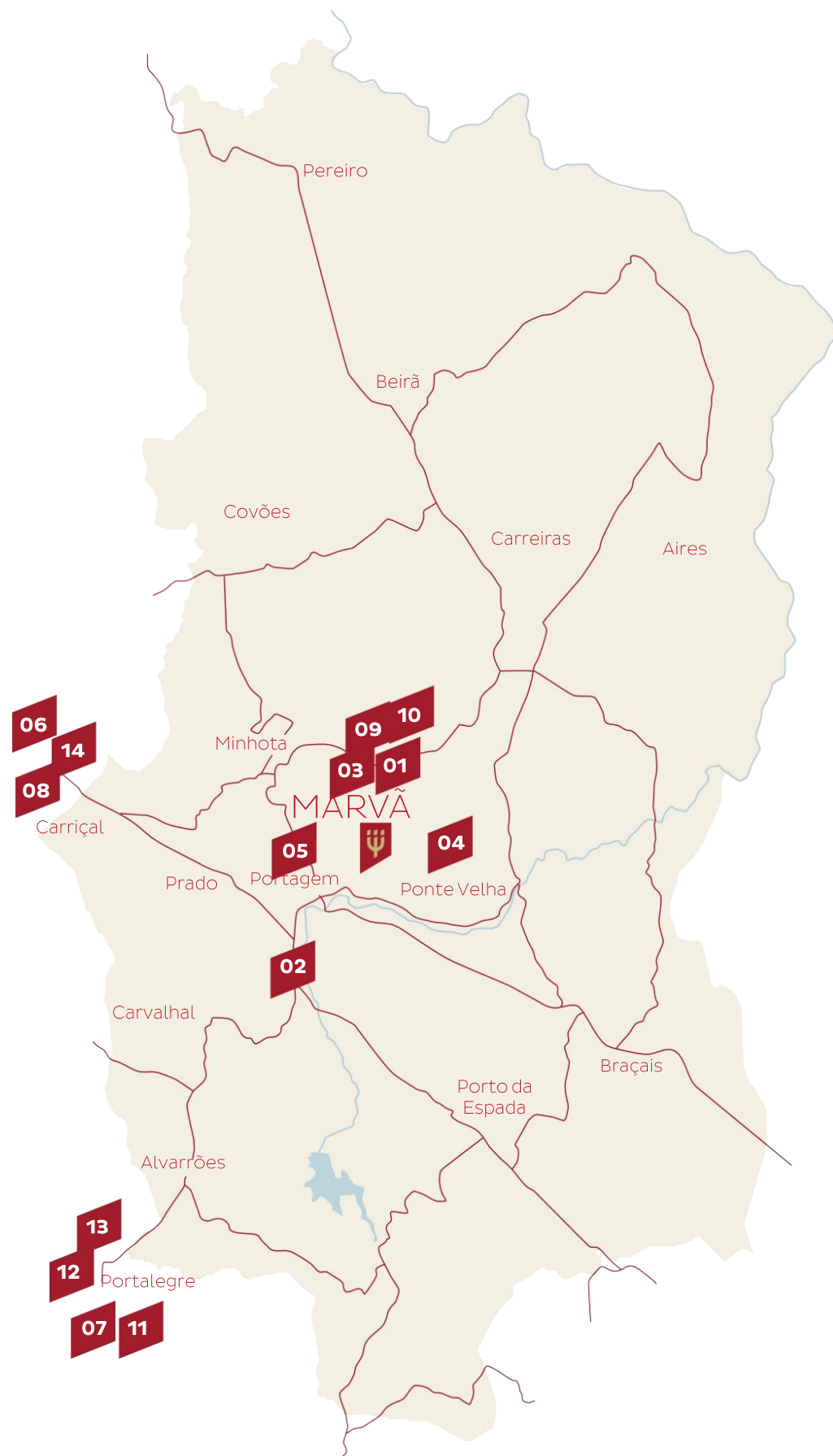

TO SEE

In Marvão start your tour within the walls, visiting the medieval castle, and continue with the Municipal Museum inside Santa Maria church. The museum hosts vestiges of the Paleolithic, ethnographic pieces donated by the population as well as sacred art pieces. You may enjoy moments of introspection or socializing in the village garden, close to the walls. This is the ideal spot for a leisurely appreciation of the rich landscape and relaxing horizon of the Alentejo Region.

In Portalegre, the district's capital town, you will find endless points of interest, including the Cathedral, the Jose Régio House-Museum or the Tapestry Museum ("Museu das Tapeçarias"), as well as endless vineyards.

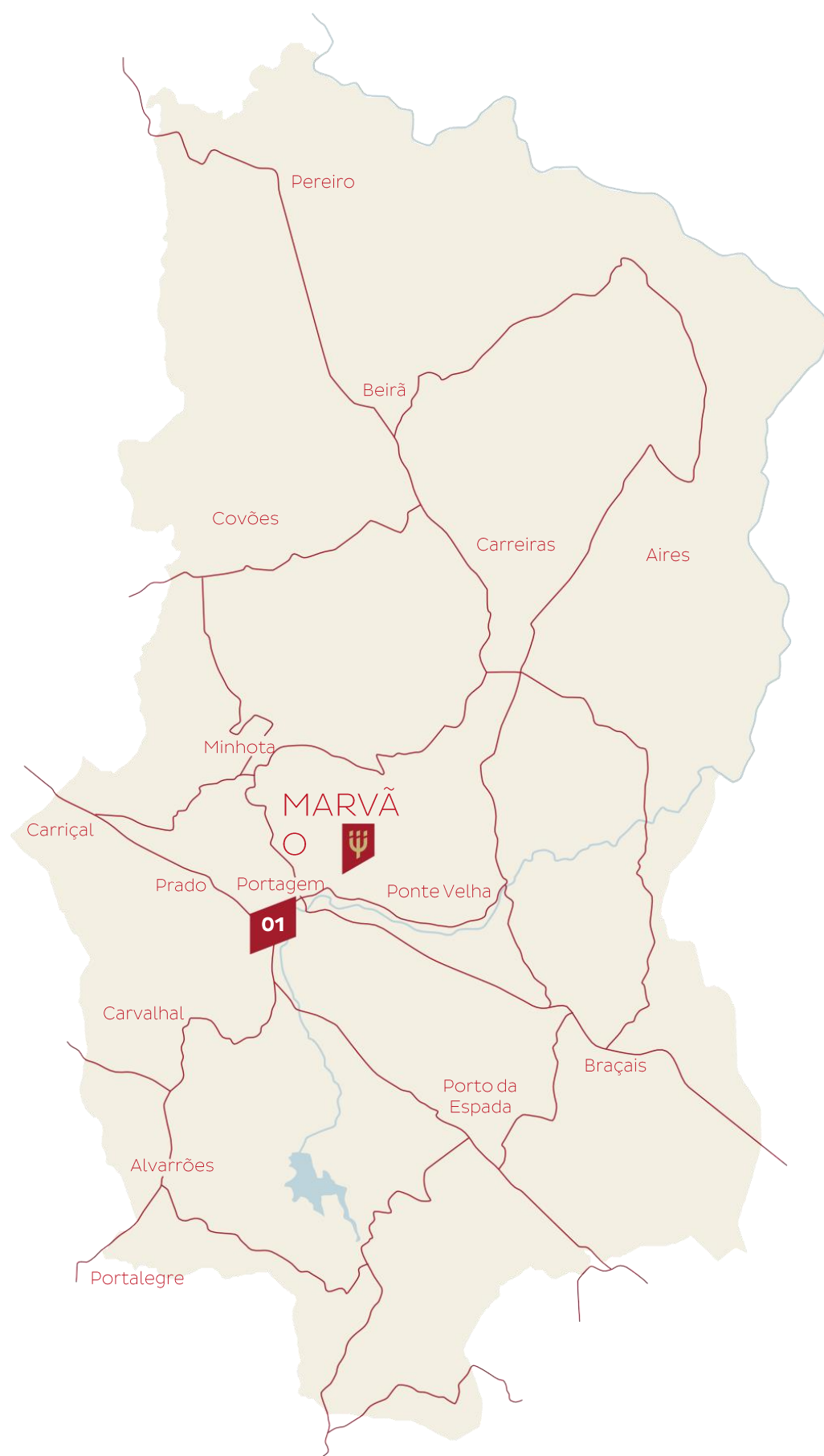
