

House of Santar


The house of Santar is one of the most emblematic brands of Dão, as a result of the prestige and elegance of the wines produced.




Embroidery of Tibaldinho



Aldeia da Pena, with its characteristic schist roofs, is hidden between the Serra de São Macário and the Serra da Arada.




Hot Springs of São Pedro do Sul



Mateu's Palace

Since 1744, Casa de Mateus has marked the landscape of the region with the glow of the Baroque and accumulates a collection that allows to know a unique perspective on the last centuries of the history of Portugal and its relationship with the World.




Alvão Natural Park

(Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies)


Built in the middle of the 18th century in veneration of Nossa Senhora dos Remédios, the rocaille sanctuary is on top of a hill, at the end of an imposing baroque staircase with 686 steps. It is one of the most important pilgrimage centers in Portugal.




Sé Catedral (Lamego's Cathedral)

The Sé de Lamego, was founded in 1129. It is a Gothic cathedral, maintaining the original square tower, but the rest of the architecture reflects the changes made in the 16th and 18th centuries, including a Renaissance cloister with a dozen well proportioned arches.
